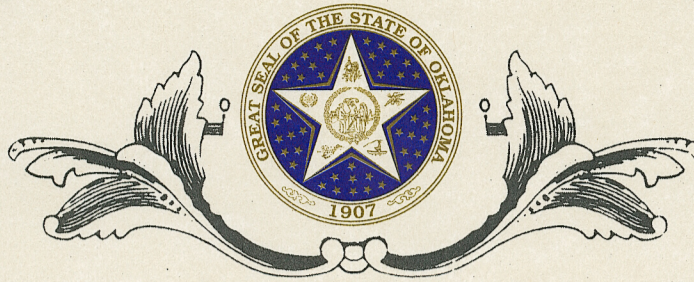

Proclamation

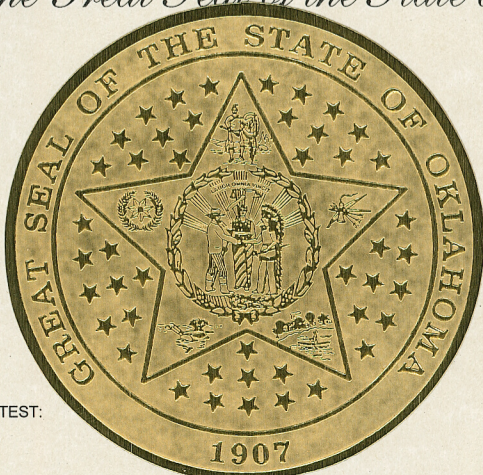
Whereas, participating in America Recycles Day in Oklahoma is one way citizens can help raise awareness about the need to use less stuff, recycle, and buy recycled-content products;
