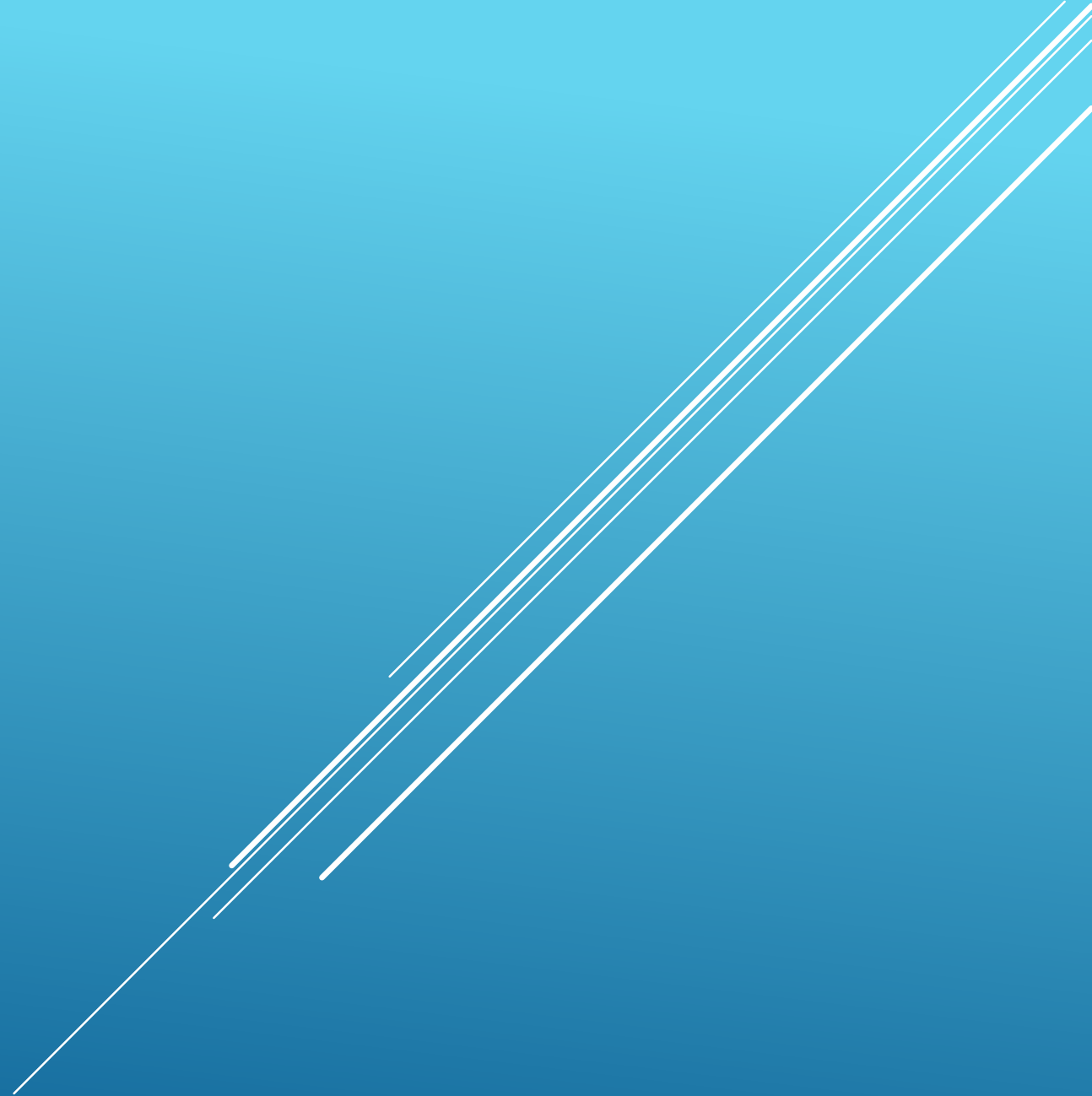

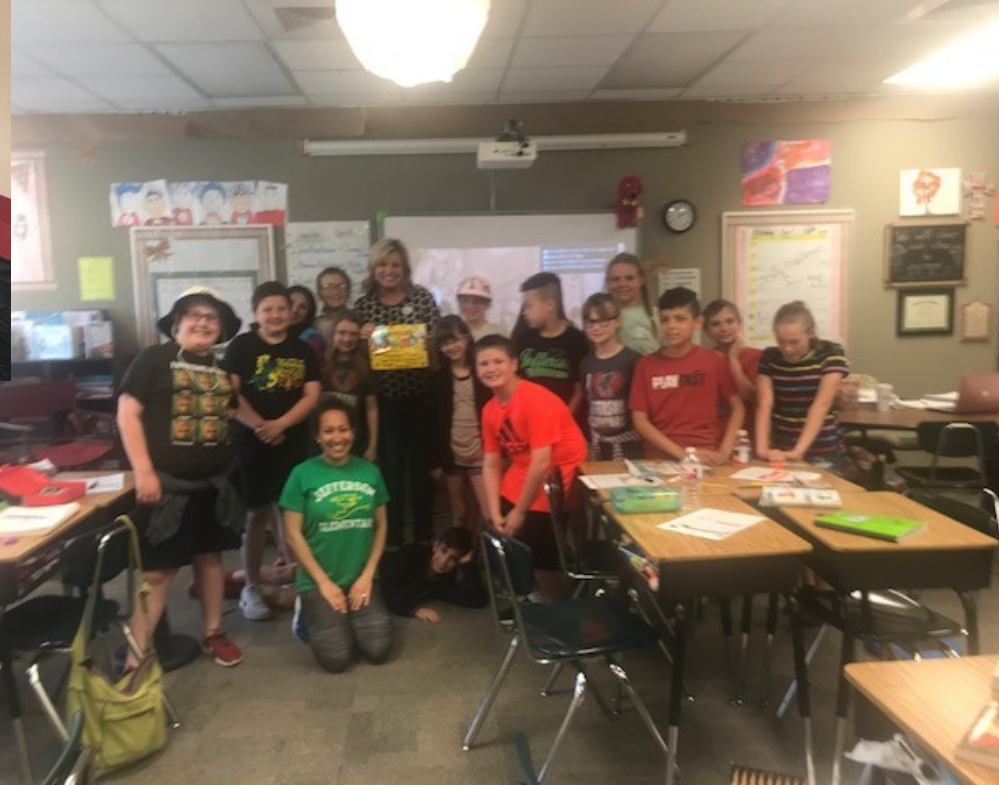
We will be participating in Republic Services Recycle Smart Contest

 - ▶ • At least 80% of project made from recycled items.
 - ▶ • Name, school and grade are to be printed and attached to the back of the project.
 - ▶ • A short essay (one page or less) explaining why it is important to recycle and what it means to their community.
 - ▶ • The essay must be attached to the project. With the students name, school and grade printed at the top left of the paper.
- ▶ Projects are due: April 18, 2017
- ▶ 1st Place - \$50 Gift Card
- ▶ 2nd Place - \$25 Gift Card
- ▶ 3rd Place - \$15 Gift Card
